based on Bruce Hayes's Guide to Features, with modifications, additions and omissions

Format: feature, *acoustic and/or articulatory definition*, list of sounds having the feature value given. The feature values that is easier to define is listed first.

[+syllabic] *forms peak of syllable*: y, Y, u, U, æ, ø, i, O, Ø, ɜ, ɝ, i, I, ʏ, e, E, ʌ, a, A, u, U, ə, œ, œ, ɔ, D, and all syllabic consonants (transcribed like [r])

[+stress] *greater articulatory effort*: always marked with ['] diacritic before the stress syllable, as in: ['sɪləbəl]

[+long] *greater duration*: marked with [ː] or doubling of symbol, as in [nɪpːoŋ] or [nippoŋ]

[-consonantal] *oral constriction degree of glide or less*: vowels and glides (m, w, ʉ, v, ɹ, ʉ, j, h, D, œ, ɔ, o, œ, ø, ø, u, u, ʉ, Y, a, A, æ, ʌ, ʏ, ɜ, ə, e, E, ʉ, i, I) and

[+approximant] *oral constriction degree of liquid or less*: vowels, glide, liquids: D, a, œ, a, æ, ʌ, ɔ, o, ʏ, ɜ, œ, ə, e, ø, ø, e, ʉ, u, U, i, ʉ, Y, i, Y, I, ʉ, ʉ, w, ʉ, j, ɹ, v, t̄, R, ʎ, B, ʎ, ɹ, r, l, r, h, ʔ

[0 low]: all [-DORSAL] sounds. Lowness is not definable in a non-dorsal.

[+front]: *tongue body fronted*. front vowels and glides, palatals, fronted velars. ʋ, ʉ, j, ɛ, œ, ø, y, ʏ, æ, e, ε, i, ɪ, ʏ, j, c, d͡z̄, t͡ç̄, c͡ç̄, j͡j̄, f̄, ɸ̄, k̄, ɡ̄, ŋ̄, k̄x̄, ɡ̄ȳ, ɸ̄, ʌ, ɸ̄, z̄, ʒ̄, ʃ̄, ʂ̄, ʣ̄

[-front]: ʌ, w, ʉ, ɒ, ɔ, o, ɐ, u, ʊ, ɯ, a, ɑ, ɤ, ʁ, ə, ɯ, ɨ, ʔ, ɢ, ɴ, q, ɠ, k, ɡ, ŋ, k̄x̄, ɡ̄ȳ, q̄ɣ̄, ɠɸ̄, ʧ̄, ʀ, ʁ, ʂ, ʣ, ʡ, ɸ̄

[0 front]: all [-DORSAL] sounds. Frontness is not definable in a non-dorsal.

[+back]: *tongue body backed*. backed velars, uvulars, pharyngeals, back vowels and glides. ʌ, w, ʉ, ɒ, ɔ, o, u, ʊ, ɑ, ɤ, ʁ, ʂ, ʣ, ʡ, ɸ̄, ɴ, q, ɠ, k, ɡ, ŋ, k̄x̄, ɡ̄ȳ, q̄ɣ̄, ɠɸ̄, ʧ̄, ʀ, ʁ, ʂ, ʣ, ʡ, ɸ̄

[-back]: ʋ, ʉ, j, ɛ, œ, ø, ɐ, ʊ, y, ʏ, a, æ, ɜ, ə, e, ε, i, ɪ, ʏ, j, c, d͡z̄, t͡ç̄, c͡ç̄, j͡j̄, f̄, ɸ̄, k̄, ɡ̄, ŋ̄, k̄x̄, ɡ̄ȳ, ɸ̄, ʌ, ɸ̄, z̄, ʒ̄, ʃ̄, ʂ̄, ʣ̄, ʡ̄

[0 back]: all [-DORSAL] sounds. Backness is not definable in a non-dorsal. Plain velars, which accommodate in backness to neighboring sounds, are also listed as [0 back].

[+tense]: *tongue body relatively high for a given specification of [high] and [low]* ʌ, w, ʋ, ʉ, ʉ, ʉ, j, o, ø, u, ɯ, y, ʁ, ə, e, ʊ, ɨ, ɨ

[-tense]: ɔ, œ, ɐ, ʊ, ʏ, ʌ, ə, ε, ɪ

[0 tense]: (1) All [-DORSAL] sounds are [0 tense]. Tenseness is not definable in a non-dorsal. (2) [+consonantal sounds, even if dorsal, are assumed to be [0 tense]. (3) It is unusual for low vowels to contrast for [tense]; and symbol usage is not consistent. For this reason, this text assumes [0 tense] for all low vowels.
